It was decided that charging and parking location will be identified by both Nagar Nigams in coordination with Transport Department and same will be proposed in the next TCB. 		<p>3. Jaipur Railway Station: It was informed that JDA is working with active coordination with Railway for traffic improvement in this area as a whole. Traffic Police proposed that there are some roads from Railway Station to Collectorate Circle which can be improved and can be supplemented to the existing roads. Further it is also decided to expedite the work for opening of Ram Mandir to Hasanpura road and Army area road.</p> <p>4. BRTS: It was decided that for improving traffic in BRTS corridor, following measures will be taken</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. The categories of vehicles which can use the corridor will be notified. 2. The traffic in the corridor will be regulated. 3. Traffic signals will be made fully operational and any required rectification will be done as recommended by committee of JDA, Traffic police & NGO within a week time. 4. Marriage Halls & lawns: It was directed that NNJ will do survey of Marriage Hall/ Lawns and make compliance regarding reserved parking.</p> <p>7. Median Cuts height: It was directed that the height of medians be kept as min 0.7 m in future construction. The low height medians be raised in phased manner.</p> <p>8. Bharat Jodo Setu area and Ambedkar Circle traffic improvement: It was directed to seek services of expert / consultant for suggesting traffic improvement in this area.</p> <p>9. Encroachments: It was directed that both NNJ (Greater & Heritage) will provide one team each to Police for removing encroachment from roads for smooth movement of traffic.</p> <p>NNJ was directed to remove toilet on Riddi Sidhi Intersection (as decided earlier) immediately for smooth flow of traffic. The poles in remaining will be changed to octagonal poles in phased manner. Work on 61 poles at cost of Rs. 3.0 Cr. is being taken up.</p> <p>11. Proposed Underpass at SMS Medical College to SMS Hospital: - It is decided to undergo fresh study for proposed underpass at JLN to connect SMS Medical College to SMS Hospital.</p> <p>12.
