* Jaipur Development Authority has decided to receive Earnest Money Deposit (EMD) (Bid Security), Tender Fee and RISL Processing fee online through JDA Portal. The bid Security options available in tender for participants are as mentioned below:

A. Payment options :

Option-1 Bank Guarantee (BG) against EMD/Bid Security

Bidder may opt Bank Guarantee (BG) against EMD (Bid Security), for which bidder requires to prepare BG before applying in the tender. The detail of BG requires to be fed on JDA Portal before paying balance amount (Tender Fee + RISL Processing Fee). This amount will be paid through Payment Gateway only, option to make balance payment through EFT (RTGS/NEFT) will not be available.

If bidder does not opt for BG against EMD, options of making complete payment through Payment Gateway or through EFT (NEFT/RTGS) will be available.

3. To participate in online bidding process, bidders must procure a digital signature Certificate (TypeIII) as per information Technology Act-2000 using which they can digitally sign their electronic bids. TERMS & CONDITIONS

Providing and operating Paddle Boats in the Tank situated at Nehru Baloudhyan , Jaipur.

A. Operation period

1. The operation shall be for a period of 5 years.
2. Amount payable to JDA by successful bidder will be on revenue sharing basis or fix revenue basis.

B. Time of Operation

1. Time of operation will be from 9:00 AM to 6:00 PM in winter (1st Oct. to 31st March)
2. Time of operation will be from 9:00 AM to 7:00 PM in summer (1st April to 30th Sept.)
3. The bidder shall have to follow all rules/regulation of the Administration regarding operation of such venues issued from time to time. All such orders of District Administration shall be binding on the bidder.

C. For Activities for Operation and Maintenance of Boating facilities

1. Boating facilities consist of minimum 4 Nos. of 2 seater Paddle boats operated by user and at least 2 boats owned by bidder.
2. JDA shall provide to the bidder printed tickets for the passengers of the Boating. Boating ticket rate will be Rs. 50/- per round of 15 minutes.
3. The bidder shall provide ticket collector, booking clerk and other staff and helpers at it's own cost.
4. Permission is not for organizing any anti national, anti-religion & political. If any act of this kind is organized, JDA shall be free to terminate the contract. In this matter decision of JDC, JDA, Jaipur will be final.
5. The bidder shall have to obtain regular licenses from RTO, approvals, NOCs to run the Boats from competent authority as applicable by the law.
6. The bidder shall have to maintain a register at site and booking shall be done on first come first serve basis strictly. This register can be checked by JDA authorities at any time. If this register is not found in order bidder shall be panelized for Rs. 10,000 every time. This amount shall be deducted from bidder's security deposit.

D. Revenue/Operation payment

1. The amount/revenue payable for operation of boating facilities for successive month will be deposited upto 7th of every next month in JDA account and its receipt will be presented to Executive Engineer. If amount is not deposited in time 18% interest will be payable. If the bidder does not deposit the amount even after the notice is served then JDA can terminate the contract and take legal action for recovery of balance amount. If any violation of the terms and condition of tender is done by the bidder than bid security will be forfeited and the contract will be terminated.
2. Successful bidder will have to deposit Rs. 2.00 Lacs in favour of Secretary, JDA, Jaipur in form of Demand Draft /Banker Cheque /Pay Order/Bank Guarantee in JDA, The bid security deposited with bid shall be part of security deposit, hence this amount will be refunded after 60 days of successful completion of operation & maintenance of boating facilities period on producing written application by bidder. If any violation found in any condition of contract or any damage is made to property the cost of damage will be deducted from the deposited bid security.

E. Location

1. The boating facilities shall be provided in pond of Nehru Baloudhyan, Tonk Road.

F. Responsibilities of bidder

1. Successful bidder shall not sublet the boats to any other person and will not make any agreement with any other person.
2. All employees of boating facilities will have to wear uniform and the uniform will be washed clean and properly ironed. Bidder will be responsible for the good conduct of self and the employees. If during work period employee of boating meets with an accident, Authority will not be responsible in any way and will not pay for damages/compensation.
3. **Bidder has to make insurance of all his employees and passengers of minimum Rs. 2.00 lacs each and all relevant laws shall be followed by bidder. The copy of insurance is to be submitted in JDA.**

4. All kind of taxes applicable will be the responsibility of bidder and will be borne by the bidder himself. Bidder shall have to submit all kind of related tax return clearance certificate in time regularly and failing of which liable for related penalty and further the bidder will be responsible for rejection of contract by the repetition of above activity.
5. The safety in the premises of boating area will be responsibility of bidder.
6. The bidder shall obtain required NOC from concerned department at his level.
7. The bidder shall take safety precautionary required under any act/law, in this regard.
8. The bidder shall has to submit the record of booking on monthly basis.
9. The bidder shall display sign board for precautionary point of you as required by law.
10. The bidder shall solely responsible for rejection of contract by not submitting of any type or record mentioned in above points.
11. The bidder shall take Boating license from Navy officer appointed by Govt. of Raj./RTO after installation of boating facility.
12. The bidder shall submit all the specifications of installation of system with complete drawing of boats.
13. The bidder shall not disturb existing infrastructure, plantation and regular visitors other than boat users.
14. Display of any kind of commercial hoarding/boards is strictly prohibited.

G. Maintenance

1. The maintenance of public facilities available in the boating facility will be the responsibility of the bidder at his own expenses as per the instructions.
2. Day to day maintenance of boats, cleanliness of pond will be done by bidder at his own expense as per the direction/requirement.
3. Bidder will maintain complaint book and suggestion book.
4. The bidder shall be responsible for complete bottom to up cleaning of the water tank/pond which shall include complete dewatering of the tank, thorough and complete cleaning of the tank base, removal of all the impurities including dust, algae and other pollutants and refilling of the water tank, twice in a year and shall intimate JDA of such cleaning process when its complete.

H. JDA Rights and intervention

1. JDA authorized officer/employee can inspect the boating facilities & ticketing at any time.
2. After the prescribed period/successful completion of agreement, the ownership of entire equipments/system will be of JDA.

I. Termination

1. Authority and bidder both the parties can terminate the contract by giving a written notice of 2 months if there is a breach of agreement.

J. Security Deposit

1. Bid Security of Rs. 2.00 Lacs in favour of Secretary, JDA, Jaipur will be deposited in form of Demand Draft /Banker Cheque /Pay Order or Bank Guarantee payable at Jaipur.
2. Successful bidder will have to deposit Rs. 2.00 Lacs in favour of Secretary, JDA, Jaipur in form of Demand Draft /Banker Cheque /Pay Order/Bank Guarantee in JDA. The bid security deposited with bid shall be part of security deposit, hence this amount will be refunded after 60 days of successful completion of operation & maintenance of boating facility period on producing written application by bidder. If any violation found in any condition of contract or any damage is made to property the cost of damage will be deducted from the deposited bid security.

K. Disputes

(1) Filing an appeal:-

if any bidder or prospective bidder is aggrieved that any decision, action or omission of the procuring entity is in contravention to the provisions of the Act or the rules or the guidelines issued there under, he may file an appeal to First Appellate authority, as specified in the Bidding document within a period of ten days from the date of such decision or action, omission, as the case may be, clearly giving the specific ground or grounds on which he feels aggrieved:

Provided that after the declaration of a bidder as successful the appeal may be filed only by a bidder who has participated in procurement proceedings:

Provided further that in case a procuring entity evaluates the technical bids before the opening of the financial bids, an appeal related to the matter of financial bids may be filed only by a bidder whose technical bid is found to be acceptable.

(2) The officer to whom an appeal is filed under Para (1) shall deal with the appeal as expeditiously as possible and shall endeavour to dispose it of within thirty days from the date of the appeal.

(3) If the officer designated under Para (1) fails to dispose of the appeal filed within the period specified in Para (2), or if the bidder or prospective bidder or the procuring entity is aggrieved by the order passed by the first appellate authority, the bidder or prospective bidder or the procuring entity, as the case may be, may file a second appeal to second appellate authority specified in the bidding document in this behalf within fifteen days from the expiry of the period specified in Para (2) or of the date of receipt of the order passed by the first appellate authority, as the case may be.

(4) Appeals not to lie in certain cases:-

No appeal shall lie against any decision of the procuring entity relating to the following matters, namely:-

- (a) Determination of need of procurement
- (b) Provisions limiting participation of bidders in the bid process
- (c) The decision of whether or not to enter into negotiations
- (d) Cancellation of a procurement process
- (e) Applicability of the provisions of confidentiality

(5) Form of Appeals:-

- (a) An appeal under Para (1) or (3) above shall be in the annexed form along with as many copies as there are respondents in the appeal.
- (b) Every appeal shall be accompanied by an order appealed against, if any, affidavit verifying the facts stated in the appeal and proof of payment of fee,
- (c) Every appeal may be presented to first appellate authority or second appellate authority, as the case may be, in person or through registered post or authorised representative.

(6) Fee for filing Appeal:-

- (a) Fee for first appeal shall be rupees two thousand five hundred and for second appeal shall be rupees ten thousand, which shall be non-refundable.
- (b) The fee shall be paid in the form of bank demand draft or banker's cheque of a scheduled bank in India payable in the name of appellate authority concerned.

(7) Procedure for disposal of Appeal:-

- (a) The first appellate authority or second appellate authority as the case may be, upon filing of appeal, shall issue notice accompanied by copy of appeal, affidavit and documents, if any, to the respondents and fix date of hearing
- (b) On the date fixed for hearing, the first appellate authority or second appellate authority, as the case may be shall-
 - (i) hear all the parties to appeal present before him; and
 - (ii) peruse or inspect documents, relevant records or copies thereof relating to the matter.
- (c) After hearing the parties, perusal or inspection of documents and relevant records or copies thereof relating to the matter, the appellate authority concerned shall pass an order in writing and provide the copy of order to the parties to appeal free of cost.
- (d) The order passed under sub-clause (c) above shall also be placed on the state public procurement portal.

Annexure D :Additional Conditions of Contract

1. Correction of arithmetical errors

Provided that a financial bid is substantially responsive, the procuring entity will correct arithmetical errors during evaluation of financial Bids on the following basis:

- (i) if there is a discrepancy between the unit price and the total price that is obtained by multiplying the unit price and quantity, the unit price shall prevail and the total price shall be corrected, unless in the opinion of the procuring entity there is an obvious misplacement of the decimal point in the unit price, in which case the total price as quoted shall govern and the unit price shall be corrected;
- (ii) if there is an error in a total corresponding to the addition or subtraction of subtotals, the subtotals shall prevail and the total shall be corrected; and
- (iii) if there is a discrepancy between words and figures, the amount in words shall prevail, unless the amount expressed in words is related to an arithmetic error, in which case the amount in figures shall prevail subject to (i) and (ii) above.

If the Bidder that submitted the lowest evaluated bid does not accept the correction of errors, its bid shall be disqualified and its bid security shall be forfeited or its bid securing declaration shall be executed.

2. Procuring Entity's Right to Vary quantities.

- (i) At the time of award of contract, the quantity of goods, works or services originally specified in the bidding documents may be increased or decreased, by a specified percentage, but such increase or decrease shall not exceed twenty percent, of the quantity specified in the bidding documents. It shall be without any change in the unit prices or other terms and conditions of the bid and the conditions of contract.
- (ii) If the Procuring entity does not procure any subject matter of procurement or procures less than the quantity specified in the bidding document due to change circumstances, the bidder shall not be entitled to any claim or compensation except otherwise provide in the conditions of contract.
- (iii) In case of procurement of goods or services, additional quantity may be procured by placing a repeat order on the rates and conditions of the original order. However, the additional quantity shall not be more than 25% of the value of goods of the original contract and shall be within one month from the date of expiry of last supply. If the supplier fails to do so, the procuring entity shall be free to arrange for the balance supply by limited bidding or otherwise and the extra cost incurred shall be recovered from the supplier.

3. Dividing quantities among more than one bidder at the time of award (In case of procurement of Goods):-

As a general rule all the quantities of the subject matter of procurement shall be procured from the Bidder, whose Bid accepted. However, when it is considered that the quantity of the subject matter of procurement to be procured is very large and it may not be in the capacity of the Bidder, whose Bid is accepted, to deliver the entire quantity or when it is considered that the subject matter of procurement to be procured is of critical and vital nature, then in such cases, the quantity may be divided between the Bidder, whose Bid is accepted and the second lowest Bidder or even more Bidder in that order, in a fair, transparent and equitable manner at the rates of the Bidder, whose Bid is accepted.

1. Use of Bitumen mixture Tar mechanical lime grinder, cement concrete mixer & vibrator is essential for the work. Which shall have to be arranged by the contractor at his own level/cost.
